Sewage  
Tank

After discussion Mr. J. K. Pridgen moved that the Council recommend the District Council to build a new Sewage Tank on Mr. Stanfield's property and that Mr. Stanfield be asked to pay a fair proportion of the cost.

This was seconded by Mr. J. Measures and carried unanimously.

New Sewer

The question of the new sewer for draining Dr. Hart's property was discussed and on the motion of Messrs. J. Measures and W. J. Edmonds it was unanimously resolved to communicate with the District Council as follows:-

" That the Council have considered the proposed new sewer for draining the premises occupied by Dr. Hart and that the Council are not satisfied whether the drain is a public drain or

not and if the drain is not a public drain the Council recommend the District Council to allow Dr. Hart to connect his drain with the old Brickfield main sewer.

Scavenging  
date.

Complaints were received stating that the Sewage Tanks were not being cleaned out regularly and it was unanimously resolved to recommend the District Council to request the Scavenging Contractor to keep a record of the dates when the tanks are emptied, such record to be open to inspection by the Council.

Street  
Improvement.

It was resolved to communicate with the County Council with a view of having that part of High Street where the old property has been pulled down widened.
