County Rate Assessment Alteration. A communication was received from the County Rate Assessment Committee stating that it was proposed to revise the Basis of Assessment of the Parish; the present County Rate Assessment being Land-£2,383 - Buildings-£7,133; total - £8,324, and the proposed assessment being - Land-£2,405. Buildings-£6,816; total £8,019.

As this would give a reduction of £305 it was considered satisfactory.
